4 FIRST-AID MEASURES

INHALATION

Move the exposed person to fresh air at once. Rinse nose and mouth with water. Keep the affected person warm and at rest. Get prompt medical attention. When breathing is difficult, properly trained personnel may assist affected person by administering oxygen.

INGESTION

6 ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

PERSONAL PRECAUTIONS

In case of a major spillage, full protective equipment including a respirator or self-contained breathing apparatus must be worn.

SPILL CLEAN UP METHODS

DO NOT TOUCH SPILLED MATERIAL! Wear necessary protective equipment. Neutralise small amounts with sodium bicarbonate or lime and flush to sewer with large amounts of water. Large spills, dilute, then neutralise with caustic solution. Absorb in vermiculite, dry sand or earth and place into containers. Flush area with plenty of water.

USAGE PRECAUTIONS

Avoid spilling, skin and eye contact. Ventilate well, avoid breathing vapours. Use approved respirator if air contamination is above accepted level. Eye wash facilities and emergency shower must be available when handling this product.

STORAGE PRECAUTIONS

Store in tightly closed original container in a dry, cool and well-ventilated place. Keep in original container.

STORAGE CLASS

Corrosive storage.

INGREDIENT COMMENTS
